The Department of Greek Studies and the Institute of Classical Studies at the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin are pleased to invite you to participate in the international conference '**Colloquia Orphica VII**' devoted to the problems related to Orphic religion. The conference will take place from the 7nd (supper) to the 10th (breakfast) of October 2015 in Nieborow, Poland.

This will be already the seventh meeting organized by our Institute. The organization of this symposium is an answer to an increasing interest in the subject of Orphism along with its various aspects and manifestations in many areas of ancient culture, especially in light of the recent findings in the field of papyrology. Our intention is to enable the specialists in different fields to meet and discuss over these fascinating issues, so papers concerning every possible aspect of Orphism will be welcome.

The previous editions united the research of Polish and foreign classical philologists, historians, philosophers, educationists, sociologists and biblists, demonstrating the broadness and multilayeredness of Orphism.

Conference fee is 650 PLN (180 €) and should be paid during the conference. The fee includes full accommodation in the area of the Palace complex in Nieborow.
